DRIVEWAY GUIDELINES, Including entry sidewalk.

Entry Sidewalk refers to the walkway from the driveway to the front patio.

Driveway and entry sidewalk Color and Material

- Construction of the driveway may be poured concrete or pavers.
- Concrete driveways may be resurfaced in a “Stampcrete” (Stamped Concrete) type surface that applies a texture similar to large stones, bricks, or pavers.
- Color is to be a natural stone color. All colors must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee before work begins.

Widening The Driveway:

- The driveway may be widened on one or both sides with the following conditions
- Conditions:
- Maximum width of the driveway not to exceed the width of the garage.
 - Materials used must be the same material as the driveway. Cement, Stamped Concrete, or Pavers that match in color, size, and style across the entire driveway.
 - If changing the driveway material at the same time as widening, the new driveway material must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee.

Adding a Walkway Beside the Driveway:

- A walkway may be added to one side of the driveway with the following conditions
- Conditions:
- Maximum width of 2 feet
 - It must be on the side of the front yard only. (Side closest to the front door)
 - Must have a border/edging material between the walkway and the grass that matches any existing borders/edging. If no other borders/edging exist, then you must select a border/edging to be approved by the Architectural Control Committee.
 - The ground cover material of the walkway must match the ground cover in the beds around the house. (Mulch or stone of the same color, size, and style.)
 - There is to be no parking on the walkway.

NOTE: The intent of all guidelines is to comply with Article IX, Sections 2 & 3 of the Declaration regarding Aesthetic Balance, Consistency, and Uniformity.
